Dear Senior:

Each school year, the Oak Grove Lions Club awards a \$1000.00 cash scholarship to a graduating high school senior. The award is given to the student whose application receives the highest score from the Lion's review committee based on academics and extracurricular activities. The applications are assigned a number when received by the Club Secretary so that the scoring committee does not know the names of the students being scored. The student receiving the scholarship will be announced during the graduation ceremony when other awards are announced. The award is then given to the winning applicant upon proof of enrollment in college as a full-time student.

To apply for the scholarship, you must be graduating from a public high school located in West Carroll Parish. You must meet the minimum grade requirements as listed on page 1 of 6 in the application package. Completed applications must be received no later than May 1.
